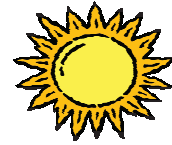


## DRY SUN

THESE PLANTS ARE TOLERANT OF DRY SUN ONCE ESTABLISHED, BUT MOST WOULD PREFER MOIST, WELL-DRAINED SOIL. THOSE PLANTS WITH \* PERFORM PARTICULARLY WELL IN DRY SUN.
