*Our table has changed from leaf size to clump size to better represent plant presence in the garden.

Hosta prefer partial to full shade. Here in Zone 7, even those that can "take some sun" will only take some morning sun; mid-day and afternoon sun is just too hot for them and their leaf edges will burn. Those getting some sun will need more moisture. Regardless of placement, all hosta appreciate consistent moisture for best appearance. *Plants will typically grow larger in northern regions.
