LIGHT TRAFFIC - OK for foot traffic one or two times a week
MEDIUM TRAFFIC - OK for foot traffic once or twice a day
HEAVY TRAFFIC - OK for foot traffic three or more times a day

SUN - All day sun and heat
PART SHADE - Half day of shade, preferably morning sun
SHADE - Less than 2 hours of sun, no mid-day sun

DRY/WELL-DRAINED - Needs excellent drainage, resents high moisture, generally drought tolerant
MOIST/WELL-DRAINED - Prefers good drainage, generally moist soil
WET - Will tolerate poor drainage, wet soils, occasional standing water
☯ - Semi-evergreen
