

Plants for Shade

Some of these plants are best in light to partial shade while others prefer full shade. Please refer to each plant's description for details. Also keep in mind that the afternoon sun is much stronger than morning sun. If your site receives only morning sun, consider it partial shade. If it receives 6 hours of afternoon sun, consider it a sunny site.
